Dear parents and caregivers,

The start of term 2 will bring a new chapter in education as schools provide a home and school-based learning program. At Enfield Primary our staff have worked very hard to develop a learning program that you can implement with your child at home and that will form the basis of the teaching and learning at school.

Below is a QUICK START guide to get you up and running on day one of term two, whether your child is at school or learning from home. There will also be an information booklet that will be emailed to you that will contain more detailed information.

Learning at Home:

- The weekly learning programs will be emailed out by class teachers and made available via our school website.
- Paper based materials will be posted home. Do not use them over the holiday period as they are resources designed to be part of the week 1&2 learning programs.
- Teachers will email and or post out copies of all login details for the learning websites students need to access.

During week 1, your child's class teacher, Front Office staff and or other key members of staff will contact you to check-in and ensure you have all the information you need and that you have access to the learning program and materials.

Due to predicted low student numbers, classes have been combined and learning planned accordingly.
