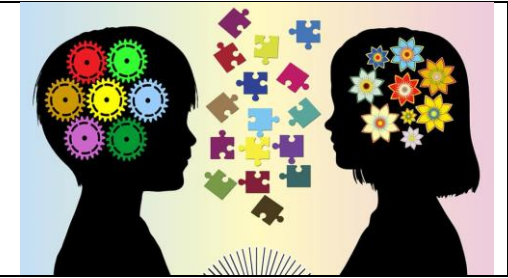

It might be asking you to Add 4, for example, 342, 346,.....350, 354 	<p>Mathletics: 10 minutes of assigned activities.</p> <p>3-Digit Place Value</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-digit numbers are made up of hundreds, tens and ones. • Saying a number aloud can help us place each digit correctly when writing a number. • For example, when saying the number 126 aloud (one hundred and twenty-six), we know it is made up of 1 hundred, 2 tens and 6 ones. • Complete the activities on the Applying Place Value to 3-Digit Numbers. 	<p>Mathletics: 10 minutes of assigned activities.</p> <p>3-Digit Roll it, Make it, Expand it.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the Roll it, Make it, Expand it sheet to practice your 3-digit place value. • Use this dice roller if you don't have any dice at home
